During this project we wanted to show the importance of first aid to both youth and regional society. We educated them about simple health precautions and some measures without any medical equipment. We invited participants from handicapped areas in our geographical region, so that young people who can't get adequate education can take place in this project. The project had activities based on non formal education.

Young Union with Fewer Opportunities

This was a Contact Making Seminar aiming to gather organisations working with young people with fewer opportunities. The project was organised in Gaziantep gathering 24 participants from 11 countries – **Lithuania, Latvia, Romania, France, Poland, Italy, Turkey, Ukraine, Azerbaijan, Georgia and Armenia.**

The seminar helped youth organisations to share experiences and get contacts for future cooperation. Another goal of the project was to provide intercultural learning to the participants.

The action included presentations, group work, brain storming, discussion and evaluation sessions and the participants gained new skills, experiences and attitudes via non-formal education methods.



Cycling for Better Life

Air and sound pollution is increasing, global warming is becoming a serious problem, and people are becoming passive. We as civil society organizers should give direction to society, how to avoid these problems. As we see, biking is one of the solutions. This project was held in Kilis for 7 days and it gathered 27 participants from **Romania, Georgia, Lithuania, Ukraine and Turkey.**

During those projects we accomplished following activities:

-) Water Polo Training

During this activity, the EVS volunteers help the children with wearing – unwearing their clothes. Volunteers help about getting ball, preparation of area, preparation of pool. They tidy up pool and they take notes about statistics of this sport. They also learn the rules of this sport during the activity, so they help as an assistant referee in water polo matches. They also have chronometers to record the timings. During this activity some of the volunteers open a stand and gather some more trainees for this course. They also distribute brochures of this activity to local people to find more trainees

-) Jogging

The volunteers help about organisation of this exercise. They also have chronometers to record the timings. During this activity some of the volunteers open a stand and gather some more participants for this course. They also distribute brochures of this activity to local people to find more participants.

-) English Course

The volunteers help about conversations, documents which were used in course. They help about providing course materials such as pens, papers, educative documents... They also help about conversation using their language skills.

-) English Conversation Club

Although our volunteers are capable of speaking English we provide them with the opportunity to develop their speaking skills by practising English together with our EVS volunteers with whom they can discuss daily topics on certain days.
